- ❖ Read and follow **each** organization's Granting Guidelines regarding grant goals and eligibility.
- ❖ All applications must be computer-generated or typed using no smaller than 10-point type.
- ❖ Applications must be signed by a principal or administrator, and by the artist when applicable.
- ❖ **Applications must be received (via mail or hand delivery) by each organization by 4:00 p.m., Friday, November 6, 2009. You must provide signed copies of your application to EACH organization which you request funds – 10 signed copies to the Foundation and 6 signed copies to the Arts Council.**
- ❖ Notification of awards will be made by **Friday, December 11, 2009.**
- ❖ **A free grant-writing workshop will be held on Wednesday, September 23rd at 4:30pm** in the Alumni Room at the Shoreline Center. The workshop will include general grant-writing tips and specific details about each funding source. Representatives from the Arts Council and the Foundation as well as participating Artists will be available to answer your questions. We strongly encourage potential applicants to attend.
