



BUILDING GRANTS

Each K-12 school in the Shoreline School District receives a Building Grant for their site; grants range from \$399 to \$4,740.

CLASSROOM GRANTS

Educators at each K-12 Shoreline School can apply for grants to support creative curriculum, projects, and events.

OPPORTUNITY GRANTS

Each high school receives **\$1,000** a year to help students in need with such items as emergency school supplies, class fees, and individual class fieldtrips.

MULTI-SCHOOL GRANTS

Educators apply for special classroom grants that are utilized by more than one school.
