

The Building Grant program seeks to support K-12 instruction by funding curricula and programs that help meet the educational needs of students in our district. This grant program provides each of our K-12 schools with a sum of money determined by the population of each site for the purpose of funding programs, no longer being funded by the district.

Funding

Principals are notified of their funded amount (the budgeted total award amount is disbursed to schools by calculating a per student cost x per school population) in June

Funds are available from JULY 1 of each year and may be used for student programs, assemblies, educational supplies or equipment, speakers, staff training, and student transportation to/from school activities.

All purchase orders must be submitted by March 1, 2010

Items **NOT** Funded

- Individual Professional Development
- Substitutes for staff during student contact time
- Food, unless there is a nutritional student need component

Grant Application

Must include a detailed budget on how the monies will be spent
A description of how these funds will directly affect the students

APPLICATIONS MUST BE EMAILED NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1

Evaluation

Submit an in-depth evaluation within thirty(30) days upon completion of the program and/or activity to show accountability to outside funders of the Shoreline Public Schools Foundation. Include digital photos, stories etc...

*Program review committee will meet annually to review guidelines, evaluations and make recommendations for ongoing funding.
